HOTEL-TO-HOUSED MODEL

Feed Louisville's housing work is built upon the **Housing First Model**, the principle that people don't have to do anything to be worthy of housing.

The path back to housing becomes difficult to navigate after any amount of time on the streets. Our model relies on short-term hotel stays, where our team of care coordinators **help folks stabilize indoors** while we identify their unique barriers to permanent housing.



OUR PROCESS

MEETING NEEDS | We address the unique physical, mental and emotional issues that come along with the experience of houselessness. We partner with multiple agencies to address the respective needs of our folks. Within the scope of that care, we encounter substance use disorders, mental health diagnoses, physical health issues, and other issues that can be both the root cause of their houselessness, and the traumatic result of it.

FILLING IN THE GAPS | A flawed system makes it difficult for someone currently living on the streets to obtain the necessary documentation to qualify for a housing voucher. Our team helps to meet those needs, which range from obtaining personal identification to resolving past legal issues.

SECURING HOUSING | Once a housing voucher is secured, our team helps with the property search, negotiating with property managers and securing housing.

FROM SURVIVING TO THRIVING | Our team continues to check in with our newly housed neighbors to ensure their needs continue to be addressed as they adapt to a new life indoors.
